

Exhibition Work Submission for “Threads”

- Please note, that for this exhibition, there is a set rate for Artists of \$30. Each artist will be allocated a space approximately **3 metres high x 1.5metres wide**, this is to ensure that the cost is shared fairly between artists who may produce one large work, and those who have a few small items. Plinths will be available for 3D work. All work to be hung on the walls must have a hanging system with D-rings on the back – please check with us to ensure we can display your work. The exhibition is open to fibre and textile artists of the Cassowary Coast, and Mission Arts members.
- New artists will need to complete a kit, which includes forms for bank details, disclaimer, and ATO form. Please check with us for your Identification code, as it is confusing if two artists have the same initials.
- All works in the Threads Exhibition will be subject to the Mission Arts standard 25% commission – please make sure this is included in the price on entry form.
- There will be a Threads meeting on March 25th, to finalise exhibition arrangements, and this will be a good opportunity to complete your entry.
- We will accept work that is not for sale, display only, but the artist’s entry fee will still apply.
- Work must be delivered by 9am on Wednesday 8th April. If you need to deliver before that, please contact Sally on number below.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - THREADS

1. All works sold will be subject to commission of 35%. All works in the Threads Exhibition will be subject to the Mission Arts standard 35% Gallery & Shop commission (effective 1/3/19). For Artists who have contributed 4 hours or more of volunteering for approved Mission Arts related tasks during the month of a sale (ie. exhibition planning & preparation, exhibition opening night setup/clean up, associated Fashion Parade planning & preparation, shop volunteer, etc.), that commission will be **reduced to 25%**.
2. Each artist will be allocated a section of the gallery approx. 1.5 metres wide x 2 or 3 metres high.
3. Sculpture and other 3 dimensional works must fit through a standard door when assembled (900mm x 2000mm), must not weigh in excess of 25kg and must not have any dimension greater than 2000mm. This will include any supports if supplied.
4. All work to be hung on walls must have a suitable hanging system.
5. All entered works must have been completed within 12 months of this entry date and must not have been previously exhibited at Mission Arts.
6. To enter, completed and signed entry forms must be received by Mission Arts at the Centre or by post to PO Box 434 Mission Beach QLD 4852 no later than **2pm on Friday, 21st June** with a non-refundable entry fee.
7. The inclusion, display and exhibition of any work shall be at the sole discretion of Mission Arts.
8. If Mission Arts is unable to exhibit an artwork appropriately [for any reason] the artwork may not be included in the Exhibition and the entry fee will be refunded to the Artist.
9. On delivery: All entries must have completed '**Artists Labels**' attached to the back of the work, with name, address, contact phone number, title and selling price of the work [inclusive of 35% commission] and any specific display requirements **CLEARLY** stated. Whilst special requests by individual artists will be taken into consideration, Mission Arts reserves the right to display works at their discretion. No late changes will be accommodated. No negotiations will be entered into.
10. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by an artist profile no more than one A4 page.
11. Entries must be delivered to Mission Arts, MARCS Park, Mission Beach 4852 in person or by courier at the artist's expense between **10am and 2pm on Saturday, 29th June, 2019 and/or Wednesday, 3rd July, 2019**. Where the Artwork is late, is not delivered free of all charges, or if paperwork is incomplete, the artwork will be ineligible for inclusion in the exhibition. Artwork delivery outside these specified dates/timeframes must be arranged in advance and is subject to staff/volunteer availability.
12. The exhibition will be open from Friday, 5th July– Wednesday 28th August [inclusive].
13. All entered works must be offered for sale; the sale price shall apply and shall remain fixed for the duration of the exhibition. All works entered must be available for display for the duration of the exhibition.
14. By entering, the artist consents to images of their works being reproduced and their biographical information and/or photograph being used by Mission Arts and their agents only for promotion of the exhibition, without additional compensation.
16. At the conclusion of the exhibition, all unsold works must be collected from Mission Arts **between 10 am and 2pm NO LATER THAN Wednesday, 28th August 2019**. If works are to be returned by courier, this must be arranged by the artist or purchaser at the artist or purchaser's expense.
